What are the different Learn to Skate Groups? What's the difference between Snowplow Sam and Basic Skills?  
I'm 45 – will I be in a group with 7-year-olds?

See below for a brief explanation of the different Learn to Skate curriculums. Each group is based on age and skill level.

**Snowplow Sam**  
**Age: 2.9 – 6 years**

- ✓ 4 levels of introductory skating
- ✓ If your child is younger than 7 and passed all 4 levels, they will work on Basic 1 & 2 skills but stay in Snowplow Sam until they are age eligible for Basic Skills.

**Basic Skills 1 – Freestyle 6**  
**Age: 7 to 18**

- ✓ 13 levels of skating skills!
- ✓ Each level is progressively more difficult.
- ✓ Skaters will learn skills such as forward and backward skating, crossovers, swizzles, edges, turns, etc. Freestyle includes jumps and spins!

**Adult**  
**Age: 19 to 101**

- ✓ 6 levels of skating
- ✓ Designed for both beginning and experienced adult skaters.
- ✓ Promotes physical fitness, improved balance and coordination.
