IMPORTANT NEW RULES FOR ALL SHOW SKATERS, VOLUNTEERS, FRIENDS and FAMILY MEMBERS

US Figure Skating, our governing body, and Skate Safe have implemented new rules for the safety of skaters and the protection of adult volunteers:

- > Absolutely NO CELL PHONE usage or photo taking in the locker rooms or warm up room. Phones mustn't be visible!
- Skaters 12 and under can have one same-sex parent or permanent guardian in their locker room to help them change. If skaters over 12 need assistance, they must use the restroom to change.
- Chaperones, volunteers, and coaches (unless they are skating in the show) are not allowed in the locker rooms, even if they are Skate Safe compliant. The only adults allowed in a locker room with minors are the same sex parents/permanent guardians, and they are limited to helping their skater only.
- The warm up room will be used for all skaters 13 and over and will be divided by a curtain into two sections:
 Ages 13 17 in one, and 18/over in the other. Will be monitored and no crossover between sections will be allowed.
- All skaters must wear a nude leotard (with spaghetti straps) at all times under their costumes to ensure they are covered while changing.
- Skaters should only be in a locker room while they are changing costumes. Otherwise, skaters should stay with their groups in the bleachers.
- > Friends and family members not skating in the show are not allowed in locker rooms under any circumstances
